The Tampa Tribune, TBO.Com and WFLA News Channel 8 will give in-kind advertising promoting Pasco County and this event throughout their entire service area which includes millions of residents and visitors. We purchase advertising publications including Race Place, Florida Running, Florida Monthly, Southern Festivals, Kentucky Bluegrass and Web Hosting. We have printed in excess of 6000 bookmarks to be distributed at USF, University of Tampa, Pasco Hernando Community College, Florida Southern College and St. Petersburg Junior College. We have printed 10,000 placemats to be distributed to many area restaurants. In addition to this area they have become requested in Citrus and Sumter County. We produce several thousand hand held fans that our distributed to several venues outside of Pasco County. In addition, they are sent to several NASCAR venues such as Talladega Alabama, Atlanta Georgia, Richmond Virginia, Daytona and Homestead Florida. In 2006, the Professional Motorcycle Club from Miami/Homestead brought over 300 bikes to the festival for their 3rd Annual Rattlesnake Ride. They will be attending this year.
