Pursuant to our recent telephone conversation, please be advised I have reviewed your concerns with Mr. Corley and he has the following responses.

As to the smaller counties discussed, Escambia County has followed the same procedure and made, by resolution, electronic filing mandatory. In addition, Mr. Corley has contacted the Division of Elections in Tallahassee and received an email confirming the process. Specifically, any local and/or county who pass the appropriate ordinance and/or resolution would make electronic filing the exclusive remedy. If you have any additional questions, I refer you to the Secretary of State's Office, the Honorable Kurt S. Browning or Mr. Donald Palmer of the Division of Elections.

Please review this correspondence and notify our office, in writing, with your client's position within the next seven (7) days.
