It is recommended that the data herein presented be given formal consideration by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC).

DESCRIPTION AND CONDITIONS:

The Pasco County Real Estate Division has received the following Agreement for Sale and Purchase of Interest in Property for the expansion of the Shady Hills Community Park site from the Kathryn Chastain Living Trust

An offer was made to the property owner for the appraised value of \$150,600 and was not accepted. The Seller made a counteroffer in the amount of \$170,000. Negotiations between the County's representatives and the Seller were carried out with an agreed price of \$160,000. Seller did not hire an attorney nor did she hire any experts, therefore there are no Seller's fees and costs. In addition, the amount of \$1,120.00 for State Documentary Stamps per paragraph seven (7) will be paid by the County and \$910.00 for the title insurance policy per paragraph five (5) of the agreement would be paid by the County. This was presented at the Condemnation Review Staff meeting and approved for recommendation to the BCC.

ALTERNATIVES AND ANALYSIS:

- 1. Approve the attached Agreement for Sale and Purchase of Interest in Property.
- 2. Disapprove the Agreement and not acquire the Park property.

RECOMMENDATION AND FUNDING:

The Engineering Services Department recommends that the BCC approve Alternative No. 1, authorize the Chairman to execute the three original agreements attached, and further direct the Board Records Department, Dade City, to retain one original executed agreement and forward two original executed agreements to the Real Estate Division to the attention of David Edwards. It is further recommended that the Chairman instruct the Clerk to issue three checks, one check in the amount of Nine Hundred Ten and 00/100 Dollars (\$910.00) for title insurance, the second check in the amount of One Thousand One Hundred and Twenty and 00/100 Dollars (\$1,120.00) for the State Documentary Stamps and the third check in the amount of One Hundred Sixty Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$160,000.00) for the parcel.
