Fines shall be doubled for a second offense and for each subsequent offense thereafter, unless a different fine schedule for subsequent offenses is set out below. Third and subsequent violations, certain animal control violations, and certain violations posing a serious threat to public health, safety, or welfare require a mandatory court appearance.
